As a school, we truly appreciate your support and understanding during this unusual situation. And it is not over yet. We need to continue to be vigilant, especially around our health. It is important to keep children at home if they are even slightly unwell and get them tested if they have fever and/or flu-like symptoms. We realise this may be an inconvenience but it is vital if we are to keep schools safe for students and staff.

Classroom teaching and learning have returned to normal for all students and staff. Parents/caregivers are to follow the usual process if students are absent by explaining the absence within 7 days. Medical certificates are required if students are unwell for more than 3 days. Please contact Mrs Taylor to discuss student attendance if needed.

What has not returned to normal is our ability to participate in extra-curricular activities. As such, there will be no excursions or large gatherings at school this term. The Education Department will notify schools when this can change. Parents/caregivers and non-essential adults are still not allowed to be at school, other than to drop off/pick up children.

We will continue to maintain high standards of safety and hygiene practices in line with Australian Health Protection Principal Committee guidelines and NSW Health advice. The canteen is fully operational and Breakfast Club is running every day with the support of staff and students.
